Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu

Day 02: Tibet visa submission and Sightseeing tour of Pashupatinath temple

Day 03: Sightseeing tour within Kathmandu (Baudhanath Stupa, Sleeping Vishnu and Monkey temple)

Day 04: Sightseeing tour within Kathmandu (Visit of Doleshwor Mahadev temple in Bhaktapur)

Day 05: Drive, Kathmandu to Timure Village (Nepal-China border town)

Day 06: Cross the border then drive to Kyirong town (23 km deep in China side)

Day 07: Drive, Kyirong to Saga

Day 08: Drive, Saga to Lake Manasarovar (drive around the from clockwise direction)

Day 09: Drive from Lake Mansarovar to Darchen (town situated foothill of mount Kailash)

Day 10: First day's trek around Mount Kailash (Drive to Tarboche then trek to Deraphuk)

Day 11: Second day's trek around Mount Kailash (start trekking from Deraphuk to Zutulphuk)

Day 12: Third day's trek around Mount Kailash (End trek in Zongdao, drive to Darchen then onward journey to Saga)

Day 13: Drive back to Kyirong town - Cross the border and stay overnight in Nepal side

Day 14: Early morning, drive back to Kathmandu

Day 15: Departure from Kathmandu
